Sub :- Sale of court fee stamp through Post office - reg.

Court Fee stamps are required to be affixed in certain type of application to the Government department such as Revenue department and the application to the Public Information Officers under RTI Act 2005.

After the coming into existence of RTI Act 2005 the demand for Rs 5/- value Court Fee stamps is on the increase. The public are experiencing great hurdles in getting the required quantity of Rs 10/- value Court Fee stamps.

The stamp vendors who are now selling the court fee stamps of Rs 10/- value are collecting Rs 2/- as commission for each stamp. This situation has created an alarming condition, as the commission collected is too much and seems to be a violation of the quantum of commission permitted by the rules.

Hence it is requested to arrange to sell the court fee stamp of various denominations through all the post offices where other all stamp selling is in practice so as to avoid too much commission collected by the stamp vendors and to ensure availability of court fee stamps everywhere, where in citizens want to make an application under RTI Act 2005.
